COMPETITIVE ARTISTIC SWIMMING / Fee: \$320

Full commitment of both July and August is necessary due to the short season and team development of the routines. Attendance at all practices and meets is necessary. Competitive artistic swimmers must also register in recreational artistic swimming. Prior to joining the competitive program, swimmers must have completed Star 3.

*All competitive artistic swimmers must register for BCSSA and pay the BCSSA fee of \$42 by registration day. You only need to pay once for all competitive disciplines: swimming, water polo and synchro. Each swimmer must have a nude nose plug and plain white cap. Changes to the rule book this year make a black suit optional. Each swimmer will need to purchase matching swimsuits that work well with the theme of their team routine. The coaches will coordinate this purchase. Please be sure your athlete knows her suit size.

For practice, swimmers need to bring a nose plug, bathing suit, swim cap, water bottle and towel to practice. Those with long hair must also tie it back or wear a swim cap. We encourage all artistic swimmers to wear swim caps.
